September is a month filled with fun activities about Family, Labor Day, Celebrate Books, Red Light, Green Light, & Orchard Time. The four weekly themes are as follows:

Week One: Me and My Family

This week we will learn all about Labor Day and what makes this day special. Our families will get involved when we invite them to help the children with their heritage sheets and when returned we share them with each other. The children begin learning the alphabet with the Letter Ee. The children explore the letter Ee while they enjoy an Elephant craft project.

Week Two: Celebrate Books

This week we will learn all about Labor Day and what makes this day special. During our second week of preschool, we read aloud some fun picture books and do activities relating to the books. The children see how maybe Jack from 'Jack in the Beanstalk' might have grown his beans when we create our own beanstalk garden. The class will create their own Nursery Rhymes. We close this week studying the alphabet letter Hh.

Week Three: Red Light Green Light

Our third week we will learn the importance of being safe while we take walks and how to safely walk to school. In our study we also learn about the many different signs to know about that help us stay safe and their meanings. We have fun exploring the colors Red & Green. The children will do activities and play some fun games surrounding both colors. We identify the shape Circle and finish with some fun on the school bus.

Week Four: Orchard Time

We finish up this month's preschool by celebrating Johnny Appleseed's birthday and having some fun in our pretend Orchard. We study the many fruits that grow on trees while visiting our (pretend) Orchard. The letter of this week is Ll. We are introduced to the number 2 and make and take home our own Number 2 pop-up Books.
